This forum with construction stakeholders like architects, consulting engineers, developers and contractors is meant to assess how we can collaborate better to improve the partnership and performance amongst all, for the growth of the construction industry. Continuous improvement in strengthening stakeholder collaboration will result in better project management and deliverance.
