Media Release – HKL Receives Part of REHDA’s RM1.25 Million Contribution in Battling COVID-19

On Thursday, the Real Estate and Housing Developers’ Association (REHDA) Malaysia handed over its donation to Hospital Kuala Lumpur (HKL), which was the final recipient of REHDA’s more than RM1 million contribution to hospitals in the effort to ease their tremendous burden befallen them in fighting COVID-19. Apart from HKL, since 22 July 2021, REHDA and its branches; REHDA Selangor, REHDA Wilayah Persekutuan (Kuala Lumpur) and REHDA Youth have extended assistance to a few other COVID-19 designated hospitals in the Klang Valley namely Hospital Sungai Buloh, Hospital Selayang, Hospital Ampang and Pusat Perubatan Universiti Malaya.

The latest donation brought REHDA’s total contribution to RM1.25 million since the outbreak began in 2020, and has benefited various hospitals and front liners. Among the items were donated medical equipment crucially needed in the fight against the pandemic such as ventilators, Infusomats, perfusion pumps, cardiac monitors, defibrillators and nasal cannula, as well as essential items including personal protective equipment (PPE) sets, N95 face masks and sanitisers. This was also inclusive of efforts by REHDA state branches all over Peninsular Malaysia who have provided aid in the form of cash, food and essential items in their respective localities.

HKL received PPE sets, face masks and hand sanitisers from the Chairman of REHDA WP(KL), Mr Chan Kin Meng and Deputy Chairman, Pn Ra Adrina bt Datuk Hj Muztaza. Receiving the goods on behalf of HKL was the hospital’s Deputy Director (Surgical), Dr Fairoz Azlim Muslim, who remarked that PPEs and N95 masks were amongst the high-volume items used daily at the hospital, where on average a front liner may need to change PPEs up to four times

a day. “We would like to thank REHDA for the contribution and supporting us in our fight against the pandemic. We are always in need of essential items, such as PPEs and even bottled drinking water, and appreciate any donations to the hospital,” said Dr Fairoz.

“REHDA Malaysia and the state branches are cognisant of the COVID-19 situation and its heavy impact on our nation, particularly our healthcare system which is in dire need of assistance,” said Dato’ Ir Soam Heng Choon, REHDA President. “We see our contributions thus far as performing our civic duty as Malaysians, and we hope that the items would help in the hospital’s battle against the disease and provide optimal care to those infected,” he added.

“REHDA reiterates its hope for all Malaysians to continue working together and lending support in whatever way they can to help those in need. We would like to thank all the front liners for their sacrifice and selfless labour, and we pray that with our collective efforts, we can end the pandemic soon,” concluded Dato’ Soam.
